## BALTIMORE GROUND RULES

Foul poles with screens attached are outside of playing field.

Thrown or fairly batted ball that goes behind or under the canvas, also canvas holder, and remains: 2 Bases. Ball rebounding in playing field: In Play.

Ball striking yellow concrete surfaces, pillars or facings surrounding the dugout: In Dugout.

Fly ball striking yellow line or beyond in left and right field: Home Run.

Fly ball hitting fence or padding on fence, between foul pole and yellow line in left center or right center, then caroming over wire fence beyond yellow line (on fly): Home Run.

A fly ball that strikes iron pipe on top of wall in both right and left field and rebounds on to playing field: In Play. Leaves playing field or sticks under pipe: Home Run.

Thrown or fairly batted ball hitting photographers' bench or photographers seated on same, and rebounding on to playing field: In Play. Ball remaining on or under bench: 2 Bases.
